

Roles of Officers

Chairman: Provides leadership to the volunteer Board in

determining that the board meets its responsibilities and goals. Serves as chief spokesperson in all Board matters. Promotes organization activities aimed at achieving its goals. Chairs the Executive Committee.

Chairman

Elect: Supports the Chairman in fulfilling the goals and

objectives of the Board of Trustees with an emphasis

on planning and overall mission. Strengthens leadership skills in preparation for assuming the Chairman's role. Available to assume the duties and

responsibilities of the Chairman in the event the Chairman is absent or unable to perform the Chairman's duties. Serves on the Executive

Committee.

Vice Chairman: Available to assume the responsibilities of the

Chairman Elect in his or her absence. Assists the Chairman in carrying out the functions of the office and the Board, with an emphasis on monitoring ongoing programs and projects. Performs specific duties designated by the Chairman. Serves on the

Governance Committee and the Executive

Committee.

Secretary-Treasurer: Oversees the fiscal affairs of the organization,

ensures that all financial records, audits and records from all meetings are maintained. Serves on the Executive Committee and as Chair of the Finance

Committee.
