both financially and with time.

Demonstrated community leadership which will enhance the

organization's image in the general public.

Record of experience as a volunteer leader with responsibility in

one or more major functions of the organization.

Willingness and ability to represent the organization in the industry

and outside of the industry.

Six to fifteen hours per month to contribute as Chairman-Elect of
