The TREE Fund, an independent non-profit foundation, was created by in 2002 via a merger of:

- ISA's Research Trust (which had been funding research since 1975) and
- TCIA's National Arborist Foundation (funding scholarships and education)

Its mission: to provide financial support for research and education programs specific to the needs and care of urban trees and the safety of the tree care workforce

TREE Fund has disbursed \$6m + to date for research and education
