Observations from the Road

Paul Wood, Tour Director

Many of you know that I own and operate Black Bear Adventures, a cycling vacation company that specializes in adventures for "avid cyclists," such as those who choose to join us on the Tour des Trees. Unlike the Tour, a BBA trip has considerably fewer participants, so I have the opportunity to ride with my guests. I have just returned from one such adventure, and I relearned a couple valuable lessons that I wanted to share.



First I must tell you that our ride was conducted during a subtropical event that brought lots of rain and dense fog to the mountains of North Carolina. Because of this and the challenges that we faced together, the shared experience of fighting through those adverse conditions made for a really strong bond between all of the riders. This reminded me of one of the best things about the Tour des Trees: there will be numerous challenges that you will face - long days, fatigue, environmental stresses from summer heat or adverse conditions - but in those circumstances you have the opportunity to share in the rewards of overcoming those challenges with your fellow riders. In doing so, you will forge an incredibly strong bond built upon the shared efforts of those who assisted you and those you assisted in the process. But maybe the best part of persevering is the joy you'll feel and the laughter you'll share when reflecting on the experience!

Ok, back on point, we are just a bit over two months away from the 2018 Tour des Trees and it is critical to stay focused on preparing yourself for the physical challenges of the Tour. I fully understand that you have a full plate between work and family, and finding time to properly "train" can be very challenging.
