A critical element of what I do as the Tour to provide you with options for navigating After I've designed and vetted the route, I one last time noting any current construction making final edits while also marking the

In addition to the navigation options listed

you will also be given copies of the cue sheets that can be used to assist you in navigating or determining where you may have gotten off course.

Navigation Tools:

Road Markings

The road markings I use are the classic <u>Dan Henrys</u>. I do my very best to ensure that you can navigate the route primarily using these markings, but there will be occasions when the route isn't marked, such as through dense urban settings (Cleveland), communities that restrict such markings (Chagrin Falls and Westerville, although I may have snuck a couple in ©), and park roads (metro, state or national).

I use white spray paint, and my marks look like the image below, where the extended line indicates the direction of travel. While it's awfully nice not to have to use other tools to navigate, please note that road markings in urban environments aren't perfect due to the safety issues of marking on busy streets, traffic that may obscure the markings, your required focus on traffic while in an urban setting, neighborhoods that prohibit road markings, and vandalism of my markings. Thus I recommend that even if you don't use a bike computer or mobile device to navigate, take your cell phone with you on the ride and use it if necessary to navigate to the site of an event or the evening's hotel.

I generate my routes and files in RidewithGPS, and I firmly believe the most efficient method for navigating the route is via your mobile device using their app with the voice navigation turned on.

Below are the instructions for joining the event I have generated for this year's Tour des Trees. Each day's route will be listed in the 2018 Tour des Trees event page.
