We are so glad you are joining us for this year's Tour des Trees.

This monthly e-newsletter contains Tour updates and highlights what you need to know as you prepare for your ride.

## **Back in the Saddle Again**

Since our riders are from all across North America, it is typical this time of year that there is quite a bit of disparity in the riding conditions we face as the days grow longer and our desire to ride outdoors grows along with the day. I understand if those desires are met with less than ideal conditions, so there's nothing wrong if your Tour preparation is confined to the trainer for a bit longer...you are at least riding indoors aren't you? :-) But really the two most important considerations as you begin to prepare your body for the upcoming cycling season are to: I) incorporate some form of aerobic activity whether its riding indoors, hiking, running or other forms of cross training that raise your heart rate for extended periods of time and strengthens your connective tissue, and 2) focus on working on your body's weakness, especially core strength. Here is a simple routine that is time efficient and effective: **Become a Faster Cyclist by Strengthening Your Weakest Muscle Groups.** For a full body workout I recommend: **Use these Exercises to Ride Stronger and Stay Injury-Free in 2019**.
