

Beau Brodbeck is an Extension Specialist in Community Forestry & Arboriculture and an Affiliate Faculty in the School of Forestry and Wildlife Sciences at Auburn University. Over the past 20 years he has worked in various facets of forest and urban forest management. He began his career as a forestry consultant before working for Auburn University to manage Alabama's urban forest hurricane recovery program in the aftermath of Hurricanes Ivan and Katrina. In the past few years Beau's focus is on educational outreach developing programs and publications to serve the forestry and urban forestry communities in Alabama. His research has addressed human dimensions of urban forest management as well as migrant labor within the forest industry. He holds a Ph.D. in forestry from Auburn University and is an Alabama Registered Forester and ISA Certified Arborist. Brodbeck has served in various leadership positions, including chair of TREE Fund, president of the ISA Southern Chapter, treasurer of the Alabama Urban Forestry Association, and councilman of the Alabama Forestry Council.
