Bob Skiera Memorial Fund Building Bridges Initiative Grant Program

Safe Arborist Techniques Fund Grant Program

Supports original research that creates a safer work environment for people working in the tree care industry and the general public they serve. Supports high school seniors and returning college students pursuing careers related to arboriculture. Award amount: \$5,000 Applications accepted January 15 – March 15, 2024 <u>Read more</u>

Fran Ward Women in Arboriculture Scholarship Program

Supports **female** college students enrolled in a program related to the practice of arboriculture and urban forestry. Award amount: \$5,000 Applications accepted January 15 – March 15, 2024 <u>Read more</u>
