



2026 Travel Logistics Recommendations

Tour event dates: Saturday, September the 12th – Friday, September the 18th

Please note when planning your travel, this year's Tour des Trees is a point-to-point route. Beginning in Greenville, SC and concluding in Asheville, NC.

Pre Tour Lodging (Greenville Only)

We will kick off the Tour from the [Springhill Suites](#), 200 E Washington St, Greenville, SC 29601.

- Our group rate is \$194+ taxes & fees per night.
- You may reserve pre-Tour rooms (Thursday & Friday, the 10th and/or 11th) by:

Post Tour Lodging (Greenville)

Although the Tour our will end in Asheville, our hotel there doesn't have any rooms available afterward due to a conflict with a local PGA Tournament. If you drove to, are flying out, or are interested in additional nights in Greenville, a courtesy block has been negotiated for Friday, September the 18th.

Flying To and From the Tour

This year's Tour des Trees is a point-to-point event. If you are coming in early, we encourage flying into the [Greenville-Spartanburg International Airport](#) (GSP) and out of the [Asheville Regional Airport](#) (AVL).

In May 2026, we were notified that the Greenville-Spartanburg Airport will be undergoing construction on their runways during the weekend we are scheduled to come in. The airport will be closed from 8pm, Friday, September 11 through 8am that Monday. While this is obviously not optimal for our group, if you are coming in early, this should have minimal effect on your travel plans. If you do come in early, the Greenville hotel has adjusted our room block to accommodate as early as September 10.

If you are planning on flying in on September 12, there are two options:

- Fly into Asheville (AVL) which is 1hr away from Greenville but has pretty restrictive options for getting there and is probably the most expensive.

- Fly into Charlotte (CLT) which is 1 hr 30 mins away but offers greater flight flexibility.

Driving To and From the Tour

We will kick off the Tour from the [Springhill Suites](#), 200 E Washington St, Greenville, SC 29601.

- There is a public parking garage across the street from the hotel at 12 S Spring St, Greenville, SC 29601. The daily rate for overnight parking is \$10. All Greenville lots accept credit cards and use the [ParkMobile app](#).
 - We are still developing our plan for assisting riders get back to Greenville after the Tour on Friday, September the 18th. Please do not book a flight out of GSP prior to 2:00 pm. Plans for a return drive to Greenville will be announced once we have an idea of how many people need to be driven back.

Getting Your Bike to and from the Tour

- Now that most airlines no longer penalize cyclists for flying with their bike, this is the most cost effective way to get you bike to the hotel. Of course, you'll be subjected to airline security's notorious mishandling of your precious cargo, so be sure and pack it carefully. Removing the rear derailleur and brake rotors will minimize the opportunities for these critical components to be damaged.
- Paul Wood recommends using [Bike Flights](#) to ship your bike. It is simple and very cost effective. In the past, we've had a few issues with Bike Flights, but it is still considered the are the best option for shipping bikes.

- Time your shipment to arrive at the [Springhill Suites](#) between September the 8th and the 11th.
- Make sure that your bike box has your name and the Tour des Trees clearly identified.
